Re : World Anglo-Indian Day Celebrations on 2nd August 2016

At the meeting of the General Body of the West Bengal Branch held on Friday, 22nd July, the following decisions were taken regarding the above celebrations –

- a) All our member schools will remain closed on this day.
- b) The entire programme will be held at Calcutta Boys School.
- c) Celebrations will start with a prayer service at 9.30 A.M. Fr.Rodney Borneo; Principal of Loyola High School will be the main celebrant. The order of service is being prepared by him.
- d) The prayer service will be up to 10. 15 A.M. Thereafter, there will be a short break for tea and snacks up to 10.30 A.M.
- e) The programme of song, dance and tambola for our special guests will then commence – the master of ceremonies will be Mr.Neville McNamara. Mr.Richard Gasper and his team will handle the music.
- f) The programme will end at 12.30 P.M. and our special guests /teachers/students/member Heads will then be served lunch.
- g) It is expected that the entire celebrations will end at around 1.30 P.M.
- h) We are trying to get around 200 unprivileged senior citizens as our “special guests” on this day. These senior citizens are being contacted through East India Charitable Trust, Tollygunge Homes, St.Catherine’s Homes, St.Joseph Home etc.
- i) They will be brought to the venue and taken back in buses provided by Mr.Victor Singh, Principal, Assembly of God Church School, Park Street.
- j) Each member school will send one teacher and four students as volunteers.
- k) The student volunteers will take special care of our special guests during the course of the programme.
- l) Four Heads – Sr.Joicy, Mrs.Esther D’Rozario, Ms.Margaret King and Mr.Bobby Baxter will supervise the work of the volunteers – they will be helped by the teachers of the different schools.
- m) The Association will hand over a small token of its love and care to each of our special guests at the end of the programme. Prizes for dances and games will also be given out.
- n) All our member- Heads are requested to be present at Calcutta Boys’ School on this auspicious day.
